TRIUMPH TEARS | Maharashtra government accepts most of his demands, including granting eligible Marathas Kunbi caste certificates

‘Victorious’ Jarange breaks down after ending 5-day fast

Activist Manoj Jarange on Tuesday evening ended his five-day-old fast after the Maharashtra government accepted most of his demands, including granting eligible Marathas Kunbi caste certificates which will make them eligible for reservation benefits available to OBCs. Jarange accepted a glass of fruit juice offered by senior BJP minister Radhakrishna Vikhe Patil, who heads the cabinet sub-committee on Maratha reservation, and other members of the panel at south Mumbai's Azad Maidan, the site of his agitation since August 29, marking the end of his fast. He later left Azad Maidan in an ambulance for medical check-up. Before ending his hunger strike, Jarange declared victory after a delegation of senior minister, including Vikhe Patil, met him at the protest site and conveyed acceptance of his demands, including giving Kunbi caste certificates to eligible Marathas. The announcement of victory triggered wild celebrations among his supporters.

The 43-year-old activist was in tears after breaking the fast as his supporters cheered at the protest site, while Mumbaiaikars, who faced hardship during the agitation, heaved a big sigh of relief.

Jarange had earlier demanded that Chief Minister

Devendra Fadnavis and his two deputies -- Eknath

Shinde and Ajit Pawar -- come to Azad Maidan for him to break his fast.

"This would ensure there was no bitterness among Marathas," he reasoned.

Vikhe Patil told the activist said all three are out of Mumbai and appealed to him to break his fast.

"We have got the implementation of Hyderabad gazetter (granting Kunbi status to Marathas)... what else do we want. If they (CM and his deputies) don't want to come (to Azad Maidan), do you

want me to die," Jarange asked.

The activist warned against the BJP-led government renegeing on its promises.

"I warn Vikhe Patil if there is any attempt to deceive us on implementation of the Government Resolution (GR) on implementation of the Hyderabad gazette, in which a three-member committee will be set up at village level, and promises like providing jobs to the kin of Maratha activists who lost their lives in protests, withdrawal of cases against protesters, we will not keep quiet. I will come to Vikhe's home and sit there till I die," Jarange cautioned.

Talking to reporters in Nagpur, Fadnavis hailed Jarange's move to call off his fast and asserted his government has found a solution in the interest of the Maratha community.

The CM said the government told protesters caste certificate can be given to individuals and not the community.

"My objective was to give justice to the Maratha community. My government was always focused on the welfare of Marathas and I will continue to work for all communities in Maharashtra, be it Marathas or OBCs," Fadnavis said.

Congress leader Rahul Gandhi, ably assisted by RJD's Tejashwi Yadav and other leaders of the INDIA bloc, was successful in creating a political buzz in Bihar through his Voter Adhikar Yatra at a time when the state is bracing itself for the high-stakes assembly polls.

Gandhi along with other INDIA bloc leaders also sought to fill up workers of the INDIA bloc's allies with a new enthusiasm and optimism throughout the Yatra.

Rahul also dropped a political bombshell when he declared that BJP leaders should be prepared for his fresh revelations of 'vote chori'.

WHETHER CONGRESS WILL BENEFIT?

During his Voter Adhikar Yatra, Gandhi covered 110 assembly constituencies, out of which Congress had contested 22 in the last assembly election and won seven. Congress had won altogether 19 out of 70 seats it contested in the last polls. Even as Gandhi repeatedly raised the slogan of "Vote Chor Gaddhi Chhor" with people joining him in chorus during the Yatra, it has to be seen whether the slogan continues to reverberate in their minds.

Congress can hope for revival in the state only after it manages to strengthen its organisation at the ground level, but it is a long-term goal. But for putting up a good show in the election as a short-term objective, Gandhi along with Congress's workers and leaders should capitalise on the euphoria created during his Voter Vikas Yatra by reaching out to the people more extensively as well as more

GANDHI CONSOLIDATES HIS POSITION

With the opposition restricting BJP to 240 seats in the 2024 Lok Sabha election, Gandhi's image improved significantly, but subsequent defeat in Maharashtra and other states assembly elections took away much of the sheen. While TMC leader and West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee last December had expressed her willingness to lead INDIA bloc, given an opportunity, BJP also started wooing Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Uddhav Thackeray, but with his Voter Adhikar Yatra, Gandhi has definitely strengthened his position in the alliance and also at the national level, remarked former professor at Tata Institute of Social Studies (TISS) Pushpendra Kumar Singh.

Push for inclusive growth and rural empowerment: Prez Murmu to banks

President of India Droupadi Murmu on Tuesday underscored the crucial role of banks in advancing financial inclusion, empowering rural communities, and supporting small businesses, while also urging greater use of technology to bridge economic divides.

Speaking at the 120th anniversary celebrations of City Union Bank (CUB) in Chennai, Murmu said India's banking sector had transformed from being custodians of wealth to becoming "active partners in inclusive and sustainable development." She emphasised that banks must prioritise extending affordable credit, promoting digital literacy, and reaching underserved populations in both rural and semi-urban areas.

"The Indian economy is among the fastest-growing large economies in the world, and the banking industry plays a pivotal role in its



growth story," the President said. She congratulated Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman (who shared the stage) and her team for creating a citizen-centric financial ecosystem that empowers people and strengthens the digital economy.

Murmu stressed that financial inclusion remained a critical pillar of development, noting the success of government initiatives such as the Pradhan Mantri Jan Dhan Yojana, which has enabled over 56 crore zero-balance bank accounts. She also praised the PM SVANidhi scheme for enhancing the dignity and independence of street vendors, and welcomed its extension until March 2030.

Rape-accused AAP MLA flees from police custody

The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) legislator from Sanaur of Punjab's Patiala District, Harmeet Singh Pathanmaja, allegedly fled from his relative's house in Karnal's Dabri village, minutes after the Punjab police reached there to arrest him on Tuesday morning in connection with an alleged rape case.

Even though an official statement from the Punjab police was still awaited, information was that Pathanmaja, had taken shelter at the residence of his relative Gurnam Singh Laadi, a member of Haryana Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee (HSGMC), since Monday, in Dabri village of Haryana Karnal district.

According to information, the accused MLA Pathanmaja reportedly fled by jumping over the wall of the house with the help of his supporters and relatives.

171-yr-old registered post bids adieu

For over a century and a half, the sight of a postman knocking at the door with a registered envelope carried weight. It meant a government order, a court notice, an appointment letter, or sometimes a long-awaited personal message. That chapter in India's communication history has now formally closed.

The 171-year-old registered post service, introduced during the British period, has been discontinued from September 1. The postal department has merged it with Speed Post, which is faster, trackable, and considered more reliable but also more expensive.

Registered post was once synonymous with trust. It

was the preferred mode for government departments, courts, banks, and even ordinary citizens who wanted assurance that their letters reached safely. A stamped acknowledgement slip, known as the AD card, gave senders peace of

mind. In villages, a registered envelope was enough to draw a crowd, as it usually carried official communication.

But with the advent of digital platforms such as email, WhatsApp and instant messaging, the demand for registered post dwindled sharply.
